



BHS/ORUK Research Fellowship Specification 2022

The British Hip Society (BHS) and Orthopaedic Research UK (ORUK) are proud to offer a new co-funded 2 year Research Fellowship,

This is a full-time funded fellowship of £50,000 per year and it is expected that the applicant will be a trainee in Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgery in the UK.

The BHS and ORUK are supporting their members and the wider orthopaedic community in the establishment of clinical networks in revision hip arthroplasty. In order to inform this project fully the BHS wishes to support research into the demographics, epidemiology, delivery and outcomes of revision and complex primary hip arthroplasty in the UK. We would encourage the use of existing national datasets as the data source and would expect the applicant to have background experience of analysis of large datasets.

You will work closely with both the BHS/ORUK Research Committee and BHS Executive committee to ensure the goals and outputs of the research align with their requirements.

Applicants must use the fellowship to support the award of a higher degree, registered with a UK University.

We would envisage the successful applicant to start the period of full-time research in February 2022.
